

USD 496 Chromebook Use Agreement

Student Pledge for Chromebook use:

1. I will always take good care of my Chromebook.
2. I will never leave my Chromebook unattended.
3. I will never loan out my Chromebook to other individuals.
4. I will know where my Chromebook is at all times.
5. I will make sure my Chromebook battery is charged and ready for class use.
6. I will keep all food and drinks away from my Chromebook since they could cause damage.
7. I will not disassemble any part of my Chromebook or attempt any repairs on my own.
8. I will protect my Chromebook by only carrying it in the provided case and not carrying it in my backpack, duffel bag or purse.
9. I will not place decorations (such as stickers, markers, etc.) on the Chromebook. I will not deface or remove any stickers that have been placed on them by USD 496.
10. I will use my Chromebook in ways that are appropriate and that meet school district expectations that it be used primarily for educational purposes.
11. I will be responsible for all damage or loss caused by neglect or abuse.
12. I will file a police report in case of theft, vandalism and any other acts covered by your personal or home insurance policy.
13. I agree to return the school owned Chromebook, case, bag, and power cord in good working condition.
14. I understand that my Chromebook is the property of USD 496 and is subject to inspection at any time without notice.

I understand and will abide by the policies set forth in this agreement. I further understand that any violation may result in loss of Chromebook use and/or other disciplinary actions as deemed by the administration and USD 496 Board of Education. I also understand that my failure to comply with these guidelines can result in the loss of the school provided Chromebook as well as appropriate disciplinary and/or legal action. USD 496 reserves the right to modify the above agreement at any time.
